## **Rules and Regulations**

1—All scouts under 14 years of age are asked to put their money in the scout club and draw not more than 2/6 per day except under special circumstances. Any money lost which has not been deposited in the club will not be the responsibility of the Officers. The Scout bank will be open each morning after flag break for half an hour.

2-Prizes for smartness of tents, cooking patrols and competitions will be given on Friday light.

3--Any scout late in for meals will be brought before the Camp Officials.

4—The cooking patrols are responsible for a stock of wood for the following day.

5—All scouts must wash their own pot and plates after each meal.

6—Absolute silence must be maintained after Lights Out. Lights in tents must be out 5 minutes before black-out time

7—If any scout is asked by the o/c. to assist with duties in any way, he should be ready to help.

8—All cases of sickness or mjury must be reported to the Camp Chief immediately.

9—A church parade will be held on Sunday morning to the Methodist Chapel for all except cooks.

10—Any scout failing to observe these rules will be confined to camp for at least one day.
